



Ohio farmers produce products that are an economic engine for local economies. Here are some facts to consider:

Wood County, Ohio

- ✓ Agriculture contributes \$827.7 million in output and employs over 11,700 people in Wood County.
- ✓ Crop production represents 63% of production agriculture in Wood County.
- ✓ In Wood County, food & forestry processing accounts for \$369.2 million in total output.
- ✓ *ConAgra Grocery Products, Equity Group, Interstate Brands Group, and Malcolm Meat Company* are major food processing businesses located in Wood County.
- ✓ 319,000 acres of land are farmed in Wood County.
- ✓ Wood County farmers produce over 8.1 million bushels of corn, 4.8 million bushels of soybeans, 5,700 cattle, and 10,200 hogs.
- ✓ Among Ohio counties, Wood ranks 1st in soybeans and wheat harvested and ranks 4th in corn production and processed tomatoes.
- ✓ Cash receipts from marketing of farm commodities totaled over \$88.6 million.

Ohio Agricultural Facts

- *One farmer produces enough food to feed 129 people, 101 in the United States, and 28 others around the world.*
- *Ohio is home to over 1,000 food processing facilities.*
- *Ohio's \$79.6 billion agricultural sector comprises approximately 12% of total output, 10% of GSP, 15% of total employment, and 10% of total income generated in Ohio.*
- *Over \$1 billion in agricultural products from Ohio are exported out of the country.*
- *One out of every 10 rows of corn harvested in Ohio is exported. Every other row of soybeans is exported.*
- *Almost half (44%) of all land in Ohio is classified as prime farmland. Ohio is one of only five states that has almost half of its land classified as prime farmland.*
- *Ohio ranks in the top ten nationally in the production of corn, soybeans, oats, tobacco, pork, eggs, Swiss cheese, ice cream, flowers, tomatoes, grapes, strawberries, and maple syrup.*
- *The average American earns enough money in 37 days to pay for a year's worth of food.*
